

# Community Supported Agriculture Membership Agreement

This membership agreement pertains to the growing season of 2011: from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 30<sup>th</sup>. By filling out and signing this form you will become a member of the Salt Fork Farms, LLC (SFF) CSA. This agreement will grant the exchange of resources between CSA members and SFF. Members will provide capital and/or (under special circumstances) labor resources in exchange for garden produce and/or poultry resources from SFF.

## Purpose

To engage with one another in a mutually beneficial relationship that ensures the sustainability and prosperity of local food production on our farm and the availability of wholesome food and a connection to agrarian traditions for the community.

## Terms

SFF will provide vegetables, poultry, and eggs at their market stand or from the farm to all its CSA members from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 30<sup>th</sup> in exchange for a \$200 minimum contribution. Contributions will ordinarily come in the form of monetary payment, however working contributions can be negotiated under certain circumstances. Members will receive two \$100 punch cards redeemable for SFF produce at a 10% discount of the market price. Each card will include ten \$10 punches and each punch will be treated as cash. If punch cards are used up during the market season, CSA members can purchase additional \$100 cards. Cards are the responsibility of members. They are non-refundable and good only for the 2011 market season. Lost cards are not the responsibility of SFF and will not be replaced.

SFF will produce hundreds of vegetable varieties during the growing season. SFF will also be raising hundreds of chickens for the production of eggs and meat. However, the weekly availability of vegetables, eggs, and poultry will vary due to the climate, the weather, biology, and other unpredictable variables. SFF cannot promise the delivery of any certain item on any specific date far in advance of market. Members will receive an electronic mailing of product availability 1-2 days before each market. These products will not be held in reserve for members. Instead, members will be expected to shop for products along with the general public, and products will be sold on a first-come-first-serve basis. It should be noted that members are not obligated to purchase anything during any given week of the market season.
